We will be interviewing for the **Accompanist** position for our **Voices Northwest Valley** neighborhood choir *Vivace* (grades 5-9) located at Highland Lakes School (19000 N 63rd Ave, Glendale, AZ 85308).

Part-Time Contractor position involving:

- 1.5 hours of weekly rehearsal time
 - Wednesday, 5:30-7:00 at Highland Lakes School
- 4 Staff Meetings per year (following rehearsals)
- 2 Saturday Day-Camps October and February
- 2 Concerts and 1-2 community performances
- 4-6 Auditions in August, December, and May

All candidates should possess:

- proficient piano performance skills
- strong music reading skills
- ability to interact positively with children, parents, and the public
- enjoy working with children and helping them to reach their potential

Highly qualified candidates possess:

- a degree in music education, music, piano performance, etc.
- experience accompanying a choir
- experience teaching music to elementary/middle school aged children

Phoenix Children's Chorus is deeply committed to the principles of equity, diversity, and inclusiveness and seeks to create a diverse community of team members, choristers, and families.

Compensation is based on events worked, approximately \$3,000 per season.
