



GRADE 5-8 CHORAL CONDUCTOR OPENING FOR THE 2023-2024 SEASON!

Phoenix Children's Chorus is a dynamic and rapidly expanding organization comprised of over 350 children in K – 12th grade in eight different ensembles. We will be interviewing for the **Canto Conductor** position for our **Premier Program** downtown located at Central United Methodist Church (1875 N Central Ave, Phoenix, Arizona 85004).

Part-Time Contractor position involving:

- Conducting *Canto* – training middle school treble choir
- 1.5 hours of weekly rehearsal time (Tuesday nights, accompanist provided for all rehearsals)
- Two (2) 30-minute music literacy classes following rehearsal
- 6 Saturdays rehearsals (3 Fall / 3 Spring) followed by team meeting
- Weekend Camp in Prescott for 3 days in late August
- 4 PCC mainstage concerts and some single choir performances
- In-state daytrip annually (April)
- Fall/Midseason/Spring Auditions

All candidates should possess:

- experience teaching choir/singing to grades 5-8
- engaging teaching/rehearsal skills that will inspire young singers
- ability to demonstrate and teach healthy, age-appropriate vocal technique
- strong knowledge of music literacy and related pedagogy
- ability to interact positively with children, parents, and the public
- ability to thrive both independently and as a member of a team

Highly qualified candidates may possess:

- a degree in music education, choral conducting, etc.
- Kodály training and/or certification
- familiarity with Solfege and Takadimi Counting System

Phoenix Children's Chorus is deeply committed to the principles of equity, diversity, and inclusiveness and seeks to create a diverse community of team members, choristers, and families.

Compensation is approximately \$11,000-13,000 per season based on events worked
