



ELEMENTARY CHORAL CONDUCTOR OPENING FOR THE 2025-2026 SEASON!

Phoenix Children's Chorus is a dynamic and rapidly expanding organization comprised of over 300 children in K – 12th grade in ten different ensembles. Our season typically runs from September through May with a break in December. We will be interviewing for a **Vivo Conductor** position for our **Voices Northwest Valley** neighborhood choir located at Highland Lakes School (19000 N 63rd Ave, Glendale, AZ 85308).

Part-Time Contractor position involving:

- 90-minute weekly rehearsal on Wednesdays (Choir for grades 2-5)
- Two (2) Saturday day-camp events (one per semester)
- Two (2) concerts per season – Winter and Spring
- Occasional informal community-based performances
- Occasional Staff Meetings (following rehearsal)
- Auditions (fall, midseason, spring)

All candidates should possess:

- experience teaching choir/singing to grades 2-5
- engaging teaching/rehearsal skills that will inspire young singers
- ability to demonstrate and teach healthy, age-appropriate vocal technique
- strong knowledge of music literacy and related pedagogy
- ability to interact positively with children, parents, and the public

Highly qualified candidates possess:

- a degree in music education, choral conducting, etc.
- Kodály training and/or certification
- familiarity with Solfege and Takadimi Counting System

Phoenix Children's Chorus is deeply committed to the principles of equity, diversity, and inclusiveness and seeks to create a diverse community of team members, choristers, and families.

Compensation is approximately \$5,000 per season based on events worked
